

1. There will be four programming assignments, one final programming project and four written assignments (Due **strictly** before 11am of the respective due dates).
2. There will be two midterm exams (Apr. 28 and May 28, 2014, 11:00 am - 12:20 pm) and one final exam (Tuesday Jun. 10, 2014, 1:30 – 3:30 pm).
3. Final score will be calculated tentatively as follows: Programming Assignments: 30%, Written Assignments: 15%, Mid-term Exams: 25%, Final Exam: 30%.
4. Solutions to written assignments should be neatly typed. No hand-written assignments will be accepted.
5. Assignments should be submitted at or before the due date and time. Any later than that time would be considered as late submission.
6. Only one late assignment, late by maximum of 3 days, is allowed. Subsequent late assignments will be penalized as follows: submitted before 7 days, between 7 and 14 days, after 14 days from the due date will be deducted 25%, 50%, and 75% respectively of the points got by the student in those assignments.
7. This course follows “**Honor System**”, where student would not give or take help in their exams, and is enforced by the students themselves, rather than the instructor. **Any student found giving or taking help in exams would be failed in the course.**
8. Written assignments can be discussed among students, but should be written individually in your own words.
9. Instructor reserves the right to modify, delete or add any rule related to this course, including the ones given above.
10. Instructor’s decision and interpretation of the rules are final.
